



Idaho Contracts

In the fall of 2002, MSE Technology Applications teamed with Portage Environmental, Inc. of Idaho Falls, Idaho, to bid on new Master Contracts for Bechtel BWXT Idaho at the Idaho National Engineering and Environmental Laboratory (INEEL). The Portage team has been awarded two contracts. One contract is for Project Control Support Services and the second is for Engineering and Scientific Support Services.

For more than 15 years, MSE has maintained an office in Idaho Falls and has been successfully conducting business with the INEEL maintenance and operations contractors and the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE). MSE's INEEL DOE experience includes providing expertise in engineering and scientific support, health and safety, environmental restoration and waste management, project management, cost estimating, scheduling, field support, and a variety of other technical services.

MSE will pursue work through independent business development and team marketing with Portage for work at the INEEL as well as opportunities with other local and national firms also working at the INEEL.

MSE has been providing project control support for Waste Area Group 7 within the INEEL since January 2001. As of February 2003, this work will fall under MSE's new contract with Portage. This work was previously conducted through MSE's original Master Task Agreement with Bechtel Idaho.

MSE personnel worked on temporary assignment in Idaho Falls from May through mid-November 2002. During this time MSE was responsible for compiling information and background data for the Idaho Nuclear Technology and Engineering Center (previously the Idaho Chemical Processing Plant). Data previously gathered by a variety of contractors was incorporated into one comprehensive report, which will serve as a reference tool for future program activities. This project was completed under MSE's Master Task Agreement with Bechtel Idaho, and was highly praised by the DOE customer, regulatory agencies, and other INEEL stakeholders.

MSE also offers a wide variety of services in the Idaho area under existing Engineering and Environmental General Services Administration (GSA) schedules. MSE's GSA Contracts can be used in the procurement of work directly with DOE at the INEEL as well as other government entities in the surrounding area.

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
